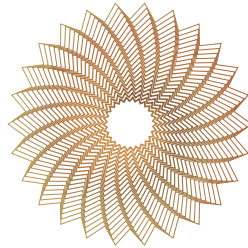

The International Energy Association (IEA) estimates that attaining targets for clean energy set by the Paris Agreement will quadruple the demand for clean energy minerals by 2040.

The 3rd edition of the Tanzania Mining and Investment Forum was hosted in Dar Es Salaam from 25th – 26th October 2023 at the Julius Nyerere International Convention Centre. 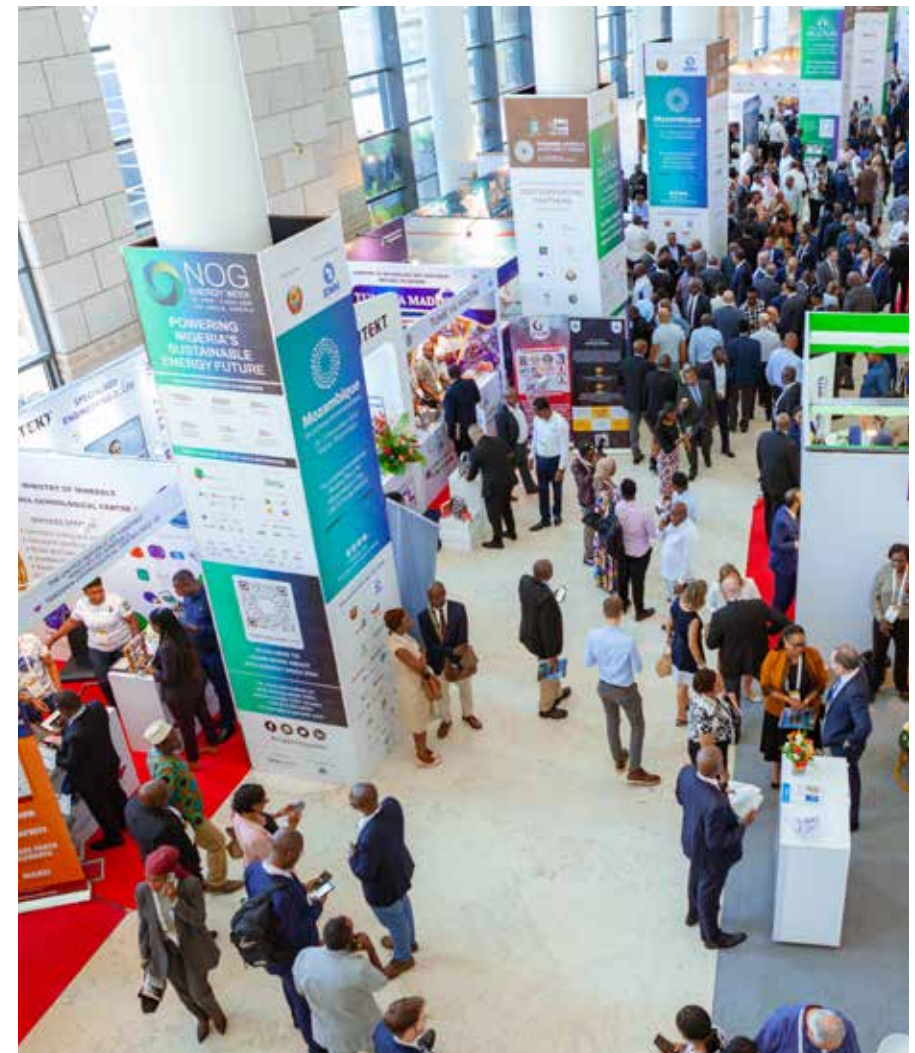

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Tanzania Mining & Investment Forum 2023, themed "Unlocking Tanzania's Future Mining Potential," was inaugurated by Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Energy Hon. Dr. Doto Mashaka Biteko (MP) on behalf of President Hon. Dr. Samia Suluhu Hassan.

Biteko reaffirmed Tanzania's commitment to developing its mining sector to attract more Foreign Direct Investment. He emphasized the importance of geological surveys to reduce investors' costs and facilitate strategic mining investments, highlighting Tanzania's rich resources like cobalt, copper, and rare earth elements.

Dr. Biteko went on to explain that geological information gathering has improved significantly and is now done digitally. The Government aims to conduct a high resolution airborne survey to map out mineral deposits across the country by 2030.

The geographic data availability in many parts of the country will accelerate deep mineral exploration investment, which is crucial to the establishment of mines.

Minister of Minerals, Anthony Mavunde, stressed the importance of discovering reserves to open more mining sites, boosting government revenue and employment. He highlighted that only 16% of Tanzania has been surveyed using high-resolution airborne geophysical methods, deterring potential investors and increasing their exploration costs. Mavunde advocated for conducting such surveys to identify mineral types and locations, thus making Tanzania more attractive to foreign investors.

He stated that *"Tanzania's wealth of mineral resources plays a vital role in the expansion of its national economy. He emphasized that their responsibility is to establish a favourable and conducive environment that encourages investors to invest in mining industry"*

In implementing its plan of securing reliable information, the Ministry come up with 'Vision 2030 – Madini ni Maisha naUtajiri' translates to Minerals are path to life and wealth. He noted that the mission aims to transform the lives of Tanzanians through various mining activities.

The ministers from Uganda and Malawi stressed on the significance of collaboration among African countries in refining minerals locally and attracting foreign investment, aiming at job creation and national development in the mining sector.

SESSION 1:

OPPORTUNITIES FOR MINING INVESTMENTS IN TANZANIA AND AFRICA: TIMELINES, PROJECTS AND NEXT STEPS

The session, moderated by **Miranda Naiman**, focused on mining investment opportunities in Tanzania and Africa, highlighting the importance of government-private sector collaboration, technological advancements, transparency, and community engagement to nurture a positive investment climate, with panelists providing various key takeaways.

Dr. Abdulrahman Mwanga, the Commissioner for Minerals at the Ministry of Minerals, Tanzania, highlighted that Tanzania ranks among the 20 largest producers of gold in the world with 7 active large-scale mines and over 50 active medium-scale mines. He emphasized various investment opportunities available in mining, gemstone value addition, and other industries utilizing minerals as raw materials.

Dr. Venance Mwasse, the Director General of the State Mining Corporation (STAMICO), urged investors to capitalize on the favorable investment climate fostered by the current regime, highlighting the modern drilling equipment acquired for mines through President Samia's efforts to uplift the mining sector. "Therefore, I warmly welcome you to come and cooperate with us, and everyone will benefit from the good environment that has been created".

Dr. Emmanuel M. Mali, Director, Democracy and Good Governance Programme, International Conference on the Great Lakes Region (ICGLR), urged for transparency in mining to ensure mutual trust for responsible mining. Simon Shayo, Vice President of AngloGold Ashanti Africa, spoke on the company's CSR program which enabled over 70% of the local population around the mine to access water. He noted, "The Anglo group is one of the top-performing mining companies in Tanzania. We are in the process of transitioning from self-generated power to the national power grid, a move that will cut costs and decrease carbon emission."

SESSION 2:

MINING TECHNOLOGY, INNOVATION, SMART MINING AND MINERAL EXPLORATION: PERSPECTIVES ON THE SECTOR'S FUTURE

The session, moderated by **Humphrey Simba**, of ASNL Advisory delved into adopting modern mining technologies to enhance efficiency, reduce costs, and expand exploration in Tanzania's mining sector, aiming to understand technology's impact on mining projects in the region.

Amadou Ndiaye, International Business Development Director at TotalEnergies, discussed renewable energy solutions for mining, mentioning that 2000 Total Energies sites have already been solarized worldwide. "We need to use data and information available to us to develop an energy transition roadmap." Jimmy Ijumba, Director at Orica Tanzania, focused on the importance of technology for greater productivity and efficiency, encouraging the use of technology in daily mining activities with the phrase "technology for greater productivity and efficiency."

Norman Kiondo, Head of Products, Marketing & ICT at Tigo Business, discussed the crucial role of network connectivity around mining industries and urged continuous investment in internet connectivity to ease daily activities around mining sites

SESSION 3:

SUSTAINABLE MINING & BEST PRACTICES DRIVING THE SECTOR FORWARD

Dr. Mimi Stith of The Pula Group, led the session emphasizing on sustainable practices, ESG factors, and financial strategies for a responsible, greener mining sector in Tanzania and beyond, highlighting the need for Environmental Impact Assessments and support for small scale miners.

Eng. Samuel Gwamaka Mafwenga, Director General at the National Environmental Management Commission (NEMC), stressed the imperative of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) in ensuring sustainability within the sector, stating, "There is no sustainability without EIA"

Aly Maganga, Director for Mining Licensing at the Tanzania Mining Commission, shared insights on supporting artisanal small miners towards sustainable practices, especially regarding the proper use of mercury and post-mining sustainability at various sites. Silas Olan'g, Africa Energy Transition Advisor at the Natural Resource Governance Institute, discussed the significance of critical minerals and decarbonization, urging mining companies to play a proactive role in these areas.

Henk Diederichs from Sotta Mining emphasized the company's adherence to ESG principles, aiming to minimize environmental impact and build good local community relations, with their Nyanzaga Project earning an Environmental Certificate from the Tanzanian Government as a step towards sustainable mining.

FORUM DAY ONE

SESSION 4:

FINANCING, INVESTMENTS, AND REGULATIONS IN TANZANIA AND EAST AFRICA'S MINING SECTOR

Moderated by **Ivan Tarimo** from Bankable, the session explored the financial, investment, and regulatory landscape of the mining sector in Tanzania and East Africa, discussing innovative financial solutions, incentives, and the necessary infrastructure for mineral transport, alongside emphasizing adherence to global mining regulatory best practices.

In the keynote address of the UK Prime Minister's Trade Envoy to Tanzania, **Lord Walney**, he expressed his enthusiasm as he lauded Tanzania's achievements and its ambitious climate objectives. He also emphasized the potential of harnessing abundant mineral resources, advancing green industrialization, and fostering responsible investments, all in support of Tanzania's prosperity. The commitment to an enduring partnership was reiterated.

Eng. Philbert M. Rweyemamu, Chairman of Tanzania Chamber of Mines (TCM), highlighted the challenge of capital accumulation within the country as many mining projects are financed offshore. He went further by explaining how to unlock the funding for the sector within the country.

Eng. Yahya I. Samamba, Executive Secretary, Tanzania Mining Commission, discussed the financing of major mining companies and small miners, emphasizing government support in infrastructure and creating a conducive business environment.

Stephen Muldowney, CEO and director, TRX Gold, shared insights on the high-risk yet high-reward nature of project financing in the mining sector, with TRX Gold advancing the Buckreef Gold Project to generate positive cash flow and create shareholder value.

Shenif Aziz Peera, Vice President, Debt Solutions, Investment Banking, Stanbic Bank Tanzania, elaborated on designing the right financial products for the mining sector.

John Mnali, Director Investment, Tanzania Investment Centre (TIC), talked about what TIC is doing in facilitating both local and foreign investors in the mining industry. TIC is actively supporting both local and foreign investors in the mining sector by offering incentives, particularly for value addition projects within the industry.

Christopher Mgani, from Business NMB Bank, shared the growth of their portfolio in supporting the mining industry, which has reached 120 Billion Tanzania shillings over the past six years.

John De Vries, Managing Director & CEO, Black Rock Mining Limited, provided an overview of financing the Mahenge project, discussing various financing avenues like traditional bank debt, equity, and development finance institutions, emphasizing that Black Rock is well-advanced in financing the project.

SESSION 5:

DECARBONISING THE MINING SECTOR: THE ROLE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR MINING PROJECTS DEVELOPMENT IN AFRICA.

The session, moderated by **Silas Olan'g**, Africa Energy Transition Advisor at Natural Resource Governance Institute, delved into decarbonizing the mining sector.

Justyn Wood, CEO and Co-Founder of Noble Helium Limited, underscored helium's essential role towards a zero-carbon future.

John-Bosco Kajangwa Tindyebe, Member of TEITI Multi-Stakeholder Group, stressed the necessity of decarbonization due to mining's energy intensity and its linkage to climate change mitigation.

Paul Williams, CEO of Auking Mining Limited, shared his company's efforts in decarbonization, demonstrating a tangible application of the discussed decarbonization strategies in the mining sector.



SESSION 6:

CRITICAL MINERALS AND RARE EARTHS POWERING GREEN ENERGY TRANSITION: TECHNOLOGIES, BATTERIES AND TRANSPORTATION

The session, moderated by **Dr. Mimi Stith**, discussed the importance of critical minerals in the green energy transition.

Ronald Massawe, Director of Minerals from the Geological Survey of Tanzania, emphasized GST as an entry gate of a reliable source for geological information.

Michael Lodge, Secretary General at the UN International Seabed Authority, discussed the growing consumption of marine minerals and his organization's global projects.

Jason Brewer, CEO of Marula Mining PLC, talked about their East Africa project, labelled critical minerals as "metals of the future," and commended Tanzania's natural resource richness, expressing a desire for expedited project delivery in Tanzania.

SESSION 7:

MINERAL REFINING & SUPPLY CHAIN DEVELOPMENT: BUILDING MANUFACTURING CAPACITY, INDUSTRIALISATION & ADDED VALUE IN COUNTRY

This session, moderated by **Kalpesh Mehta** of Oryx Energies, explored refining minerals and developing the supply chain in Tanzania.

Daniel Kidesheni from Tanzanian Gemological Centre, emphasized zero waste mining.

Benedict Busunzu from Tembo Nickel, highlighted their game-changing Kabanga project utilizing green refining technology.

Humphrey Simba from ASNL Advisory Limited, discussed leveraging the mining value chain and emphasized local content, especially in supply chain and procurement. He suggested that mining companies should have employment guidelines that promote inclusivity for all individuals, including those with disabilities.

Phillip Schmidt-thome from Geological survey of Finland highlighted GTK's role in providing impartial research to support industry decisions towards a sustainable, carbon-neutral world.

SESSION 8:

COMPLIANCE POLICIES IN TANZANIA'S MINING SECTOR: OPENING OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL THROUGH AN INCLUSIVE SECTOR

Moderated by **Miranda Naiman** from Empower, the emphasis was on fostering an inclusive mining sector in Tanzania through compliance policies.

Engr. Lightness Salema from Women in Mining Operations, highlighted her organization's initiatives toward economically empowering women within the industry.

On the other hand, **Theonestina Mwasha**, representing TEITI Multi-Stakeholder Group, discussed government strategies to support women in mining, and how local content in the mining supply chain benefits women.

SESSION 9:

LOCAL CONTENT FACILITATING THE TRANSFORMATION OF SMALL- AND LARGE- SCALE MINING IN TANZANIA AND AFRICAN CONTINENT

In Session 9, moderated by **Tiago Marques** from dmg events, the dialogue revolved around local content in Tanzania's mining sector.

Janet Reuben Lekashingo from the Tanzania Mining Commission, shared the progress of local content, highlighting an increase in local employment and procurement. She said, "Local content journey is in motion".

Osman Abdulsattar Tharia of TAMIDA, emphasized the need for a conducive business environment to attract local investors.

Godwin Zimba from The Impact Facility, discussed their local initiatives and ESG considerations.

Jackson Emmanuel Kanza talked about the support, especially technical, received by artisanal and small-scale miners from key stakeholders to further their progress in the sector.

SESSION 10:

BUILDING CAPACITY, NURTURING TALENT & DEVELOPING THE LEADERS OF TOMORROW

Session 10, moderated by **Janet Reuben Lekashingo** from the Tanzania Mining Commission, focused on building capacity and nurturing future leaders.

Dr. Willison Mugatwaba from MTL Consulting, emphasized the importance of capacity building for the youth, considering Tanzania's rich resources.

Perfect **Listera Belegele** from the Federation of Miners Association of Tanzania (FEMATA), commends the government's efforts in strengthening the investment climate in the mining sector for local small and medium miners.

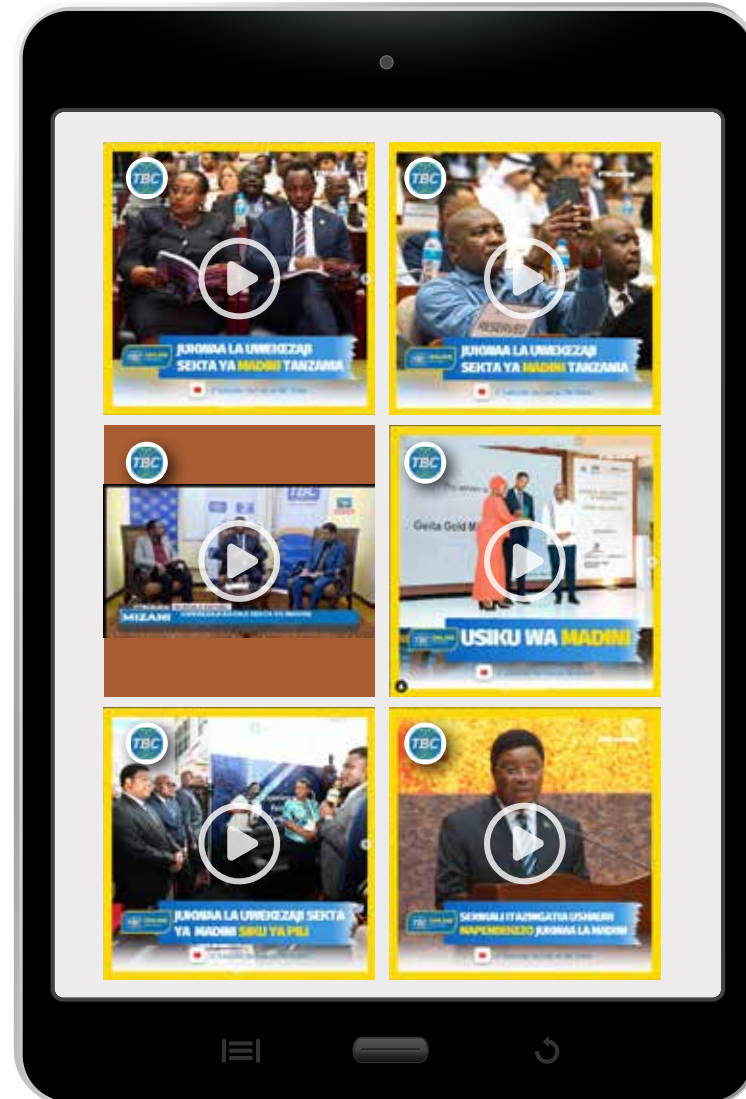

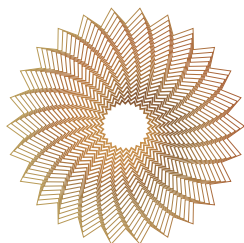
